HAGAS President's Report 2008-09

The past twelve months has been a rewarding period for the Henley & Grange Arts Society. With almost full adult classes over the twelve month period, increased membership, demand for children's classes, well attended social painting on Wednesday and Saturday, and organised social activity we can allow ourselves to be optimistic about the future of our society.

The spring exhibition, the result of much preparation and hard work by many of our members was the most successful ever, enabling us to promote our society to the many people who attended. Paintings donated to our exhibition by the Thursday morning class was a much appreciated gesture, with many sold and all the monies going to the society.

The gallery, as always, is still a concern to all committee members. Despite being open every Saturday afternoon, thanks to those members on duty, our sales and the number of people it attracts is extremely disappointing.

Our tutors continue to provide a high standard of tuition for our students. The appointment of a social activity organiser provided members with a variety of outings we have lacked in our society for a long time.

With the increase in our pottery and glass activities an upgrade of equipment has been carried out. Our fire safety equipment has been reviewed. We now have three new extinguishers and a fire blanket. Extinguishers are located in foyer, art room and pottery studio, and fire blanket in the kitchen.

During the past 22 months I have had the duty of negotiating a new lease agreement with the City of Charles Sturt. Unfortunately these issues take some time to reach agreement. During the whole 22 month period I have been fortunate to have continued contact with the same council property liaison officer.

We have now finalised our lease agreement signed by the Mayor and the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Charles Sturt and signed for HAGAS by our Public Officer Colin Giles and myself as President. We now have a lease for the Henley & Grange Arts Society of ten (10) years with the right to renew for a further 10 years. This agreement provides an assurance of occupation for the period 01 January 2008 to 31 December 2017, then the right of renewal 01 January 2018 to 31 December 2027. To those people who assisted with required research of information we needed to provide to the Council, I say 'thankyou'.

In closing I wish to say a special thankyou to John Aird who is not continuing as Treasurer. John stepped in and helped us through a difficult period after the passing of long-term treasurer Bernie Franzon. I also take this opportunity to thank members both on and off the committee who supported me in my role as President and for their contribution to our society in 2008/2009.
