

# Portrait Painting in Oils

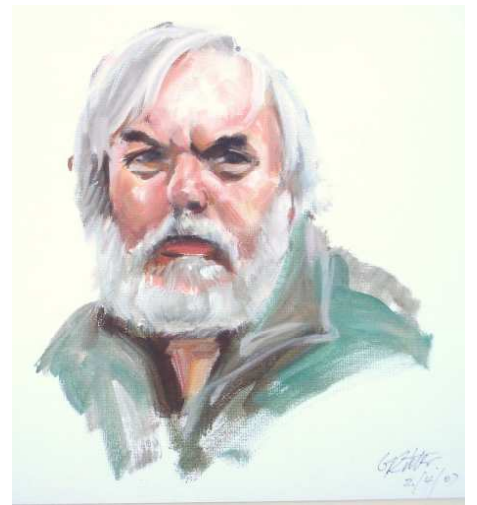


Try something different and treat yourself to this fun and informative 4 week workshop.

## **Painting Hints ... things to consider**

- Are you using the subject to create a 'painting' – or the painting to recreate the subject?
- It is more important that the painting looks good than it is to be accurate
- The tones / tonal balance is more important than the colours themselves – so mix your colours to match the tones not the hues
- Centre of focus is better slightly off centre
- Background must be integral to the painting from the start.

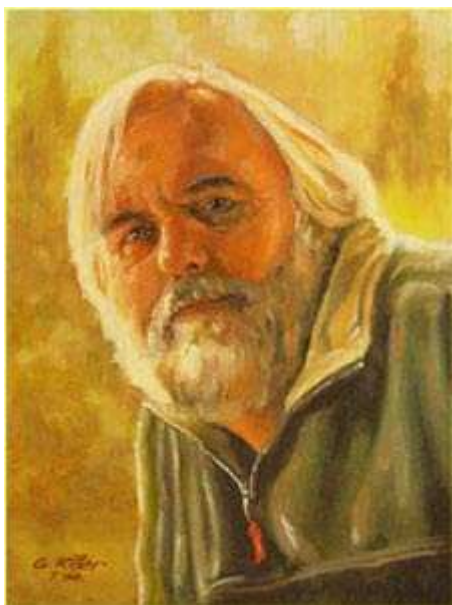
