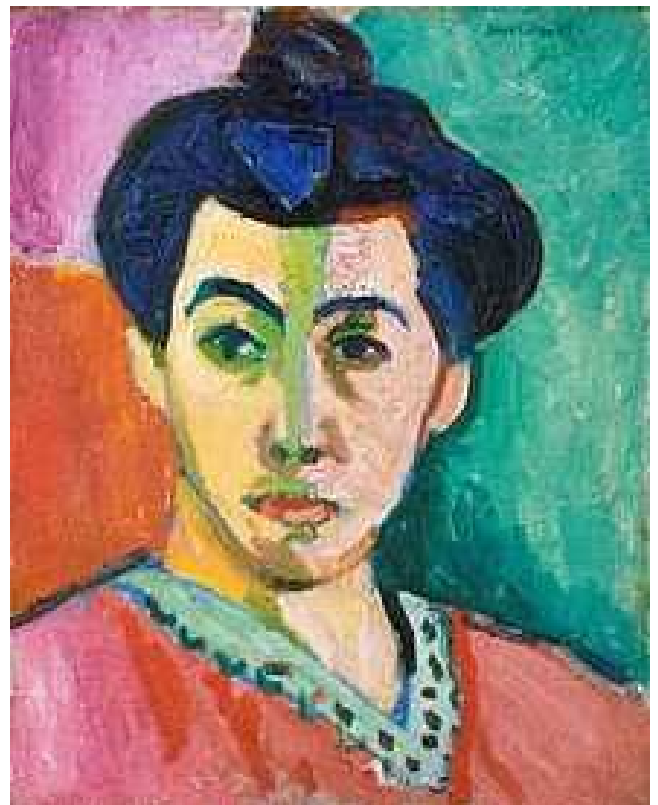

Who were the Fauves?

'Fauvism' was a short-lived art movement lasting only three years from 1905 -1907. Traditionally colour was part of the realistic visual representation of form but this group of painters abandoned these practices regarding colour in painting.

The artists shared their first exhibition at the 1905 Salon d'Automne.. They gained their name after a critic described their show of work with the phrase "Donatello au milieu des fauves!" ("Donatello among the wild beasts") contrasting the paintings with a Renaissance - type sculpture that shared the room with them.

Led by Henri Matisse, their exuberant use of brilliant hues seemed to disregard local colour. Whereas other artists used colour as the description of an object, the Fauves let colour become the subject of their painting. A painting in the "Fauvist Manner" was one that related colour shapes; rather than unifying a design with line, compositions sought an expressiveness within the relationships of the whole. This turn from tradition brought an integrity to colour in that colour was regarded on its own merit, and heralded the beginning of Modernism in European Art.

Mosaic Madness

For those of you who have been in our studio over the last few weeks you will have noticed some half finished mosaic designs. The capable students (and some mums!) from our Saturday and Thursday classes have been creating these to complete a community art project to be installed at the Athol Park Child and Community Centre. Funded by the City of Charles Sturt, we also held workshops at the Athol Park Neighbourhood House and Parks Community Centre.

The technique we are using is easily applied to most circumstances, is flexible and easily transferred / installed to many different surfaces.

This project has generated much interest among HAGAS members – so much so that we are offering two Saturday morning workshops open to all members to come and learn the basics. Depending on the response, this could lead to a 'members' project for installation at HAGAS. *See workshop details below.*

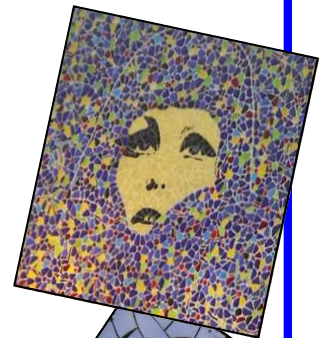
Mosaic Basics
